Subscription Plans and Pricing

There are as many ways to run a fundraising event as there are fundraising events; we know that better than most. So we don't even try to have a one-size-fits-all plan. When you sign up with us, you can choose from 4 plans; 3 of which are annual plans with a fixed subscription cost, and a single-event plan which is priced based on how much you raise.

Acorn | \$79/event, plus 3% performance fee

Let's start with that single-event plan. It has everything you need to run either an in-person gala event (with traditional, paper-based bidding and/or mobile bidding), an online silent auction, or a combination of both. It comes with our standard support and is an easy-to-buy, easy-to-use option for groups without a large budget for their event.

The costs associated with our Acorn plan fall into three buckets: you pay us an initial set-up fee of \$79, and then a performance fee of 3% of the funds you raise. In addition, our credit card processor will charge 3% + \$0.30/transaction on all credit card payments.

If you would prefer not to pay us 3% of what you raise, we also offer flat-fee annual subscriptions. These allow you to use the software for multiple fundraisers over the course of one year and come without the 3% performance fee. (Credit card processing fees still apply – the bank insists on charging for their services.) Based on what you want your main event to look like, we offer different options with different feature sets.

Essentials | \$1,000/year

Everything you will need to run a traditional fundraising auction - one where your guests bid using paper bid sheets and paddles. This is also a reasonable choice if your fundraiser is online-only, with no event. Credit card processing is included, at a rate of 3% + \$0.30/transaction. Comes with email support before your event, and telephone support on the night of your event.



Plus | \$1,500/year

Our Plus subscription adds a lot of features to our Essentials plan, including:

- Mobile Bidding for your in-person silent auction
- Text-To-Give donations
- Recurring donations
- Use your own credit card processor (subject to compatibility)
- Talent Contests
- Online stores
- Pledge events (i.e., jog-a-thons, read-a-thons)
- Advanced credit card processing tools

If your school or nonprofit organization holds a variety of fundraisers throughout the year, our Plus subscription is the most cost-effective solution on the market.

Professional | \$2,000/year

Our Professional subscription adds the capacity to hold Virtual Live Auctions, complete with livestreaming video, and the ability to accommodate both remote and in-person guests for your live auction event. These are complicated events, and so we also add custom training webinars to help make sure everything runs smoothly.
